1. DNREC Secretary - ACEC/DE - DNREC Partnering Meetings

2. DNREC Sediment & Stormwater (S&S) Regulation Revision

The Sediment & Stormwater (S&S) Regulation Revision Regulatory Advisory committee, Technical Subcommittee met on May 6, 2009 to begin a detailed review of the proposed regulation revisions. Based on the discussion regarding the best strategy to begin developing the Technical Documents associated with the regulations, the group felt it would be necessary to meet once a month. It was agreed that these meetings would be held on the first Wednesday of each month. Therefore, the meeting schedule breaks out as follows:
